## CENTRAL REBATE QUALIFICATIONS GROUND SOURCE HEAT PUMPS 2016

#### Qualifications and Listing of items need to Process Rebate:

- 1. Please complete all the information on the application. Include your account number and sign the form. The retailer-contractor information must be completed and signed by the contractor who installed the heat pump. A separate application must be submitted for each unit installed.
- 2. A copy of the paid sales receipt or invoice must be included with the rebate application. The receipt should reflect the model, model number, the ton/size of the unit installed and the SEER rating of the unit.
- 3. Equipment must meet the ENERGY STAR + 2 EER rating of 19.1.
- 4. When replacing the indoor ground source heat pump unit only, the compressor being replaced must be a gain of a 3 EER rating and a minimum EER 19.1 to qualify for the Cooperative's rebate program.
- 5. The home must meet the insulation requirements of R-38 for ceiling and R-13 for the walls. Please ask your HVAC contractor or builder for written confirmation of the insulation requirements. The Cooperative may inspect the home to determine if the minimum insulation requirements have been met. Please submit the contractor's written verification of the insulation rating.
- 6. A copy of the paid sales receipt or invoice must be included with the rebate application. The receipt/invoice should reflect the model, model number, the ton/size of the unit installed and the EER rating of the unit.
- 7. Your HVAC contractor needs to provide a copy of the Manual J "residential load calculation."

#### **General Information:**

- Rebate offered by the Cooperative for ground source heat pump with loop is \$750.00 per ton. Rebate offered by the Cooperative for ground source heat pump unit only replacement is \$150.00 per ton.
- The ground source heat pump must be installed where electricity is supplied by the cooperative.
- Residential ground source heat pump rebates will not exceed 10 tons.
- Rebates are available for replacement or new construction.
- Please allow 6-8 weeks for rebate processing. Incomplete applications will not be processed for rebates. Please keep a copy for your records.
- Recipients of rebates may be requested to participate in a future email or phone surveys.
- Heat pumps that receive rebates may be subject to Cooperative load control programs.
   The participant agrees to allow the Cooperative to control their heating and cooling equipment now or in the future.
- The Cooperative does not rebate DX direct expansion ground source heat pump installations.

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### GROUND SOURCE HEAT PUMP REBATE APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS

#### **ELIGIBLE CUSTOMERS**

- Cooperative residential members are eligible for rebates when buying qualifying ground source (geothermal) heat pumps.
- The structure in which the member resides must be a permanent structure on a permanent foundation on the land owned by the member.
- Rebates are limited to eligible services (homes, lake homes, shops, barns, etc) that use more than 6,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity on an annual basis.

#### ELIGIBLE HEAT PUMP EQUIPMENT

- Equipment must meet the ENERGY STAR +2 EER rating of 19.1 for equipment installed after December 31, 2011.
- For cooperative systems <u>NORTH</u> of the Missouri River, ground source heat pumps must be installed with a Delta-T of 80 supported by a Manual J "Residential Load Calculation" published by the Air Conditioning Contractors of America (ACCA). Please ask your HVAC contractor to verify that these requirements are met.
- For cooperative systems <u>SOUTH</u> of the Missouri River, ground source heat pumps must be installed with a Delta-T of 70 supported by a Manual J "Residential Load Calculation" published by the Air Conditioning Contractors of America (ACCA). Please ask your HVAC contractor to verify that these requirements are met.
- The Cooperative may inspect the home to determine if a minimum of R-38 insulation is present in the ceiling and R-13 in the walls.
- Heat pumps that receive rebates **may be subject to cooperative load control programs.** The participant agrees to allow the Cooperative to control their heating and cooling equipment now or in the future.
- DX (direct expansion) ground source heat pump installations are not eligible for rebates.

#### ELIGIBLE HEAT PUMP EQUIPMENT

• *Space Heating:* The heat pump may be used to replace existing heat pumps, electric resistance or fossil fuel equipment in the home.

#### **REBATE DETAILS**

- Please submit one rebate application per heat pump. Attach additional sheets for multiple units.
- The application must include all the information requested on the front of this application.
- Recipients of rebates may be requested to participate in a future survey by phone or e-mail.
- INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED AND WILL BE RETURNED TO THE MEMBER
- Please allow 6-8 weeks for rebate processing. Please keep a copy for your records.
