This Request for Proposal is issued to gather information from qualified vendors regarding dark fiber lease services to support Centranet's telecommunications and data connectivity requirements.

Centranet is a subsidiary of Central Rural Electric Cooperative providing broadband services utilizing Fiber to the Home. Over the last five years, Centranet has built a 3300-mile fiber network to service several counties in rural Oklahoma. We are looking for dark fiber that would enable connectivity between Centranet's network and data centers in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
